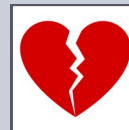

St. Joseph—A Patron for Us All

A Man of Action

In silence, St. Joseph could hear God speak—especially through dreams, like the Joseph of the Old Testament. And because he was a man of prayer, reflection, and virtue, he was prepared to act on God's word. Joseph's actions in the Scripture demonstrate how he allowed God's word to be planted in the world, to bear fruit that would last. His obedience to God, by his actions, help set the stage for the Word to become flesh so that the world might have life.

Sacrificial and Selfless

The gospel shows that Joseph does not question God's plan. Nor does he waste time or exhibit concern for himself. Instead, he is a man who lives for others, one who does not count the cost of what doing God's will might entail. Amid the unique and often difficult circumstances of his life with Mary and Jesus, Joseph does not give in to any fear or temptation to doubt. When God's angel commands him to bring the Holy Family to Egypt, in order to spare Christ from Herod's persecution, or to return to their home in Nazareth, he responds in faith. One can only imagine the disruption to his life—to his livelihood, his profession, his family, and more—but, silently and selflessly he obeys. Joseph lays down his life for his beloved wife and her holy Son.
