THE HOLY SPIRIT

In second grade, at St. William's School, Sister Mary taught me about the Holy Spirit. She taught that the Holy Spirit comforts and guides us to

do what is right. She helped me to learn to call on the Holy Spirit when I need help—preparing for confession, getting ready to take a test, or troubled and unsure of what to do.

As a child, believing that the Holy Spirit would help me was foundational. Even today, Sister Mary's advice remains embedded in my soul. I still rely on the Holy Spirit's guidance when searching for the right path to take.

As we mature, we are called to learn from Scripture and Church teaching more about the Holy Spirit's workings and the rich help that He provides to the Church.

Who is the Holy Spirit?

As it was even prior to creation, God exists eternally as a Trinity of Persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As the Trinity, these three Persons are inseparable - equal in one divine nature, yet different as distinct persons. The Nicene Creed says the Holy Spirit "proceeds from the Father and the Son." The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states that the Holy Spirit is "consubstantial [meaning 'with the same nature or substance'] with the Father and the Son" (689).

The Western (Roman) Catholic tradition says that in the inner life of the Trinity the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father *and* the Son. The Eastern Catholic tradition says that the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father by indicating that he "*comes from the Father through the Son* (cf. *Ad Gentes, 2*)" (CCC248). In both traditions, God's Trinitarian nature is a mystery and would have forever remained unknown to us were it not divinely revealed by God. (*cont. in next bulletin*)
