Declaring Saints—How the Canonization Process Works

Miracles - The presence of miracles typically has been a part of the declaration of saints even from earliest times. While supernatural phenomena might have been present in the holy person's life, it is the miracles that occur after the person's death that give evidence to his or her intercessory closeness to God as a heavenly denizen.

The Church takes very seriously the task of authenticating alleged miracles, and reported miracles typically are inexplicable medical healings. They are subjected to thorough investigations by medical and theological experts. After examination, ratification, and endorsement by local and Roman commissions, alleged miracles are submitted to the Pope for his ultimate approval. One miracle is required for beatification and a second for canonization (after the beatification, sometimes viewed as affirmation of the saint's cause) except in the case of martyrs, for whom the first miracle is exempted. Greetings! My name is Father Prasanna Mese, a missionary priest from the Diocese of Kurnool in southern India, where I was ordained in 2010. After serving for ten years in Texas (2012-2022), I returned to my home diocese to continue ministering to the faithful. I want to share with you the realities and needs of the Catholic community in India. Our mission addresses significant challenges, including:

- Providing free education to over 1,500 impoverished children.*
- Offering medical assistance and housing to the disadvantaged.*
- Fostering the self-empowerment of women.*
- Carrying out evangelization efforts.*

In India, Christians are a minority, with Catholics making up only 1% of the population. Our diocese has 155 priests and 438 religious sisters dedicated to serving the poor. Additionally, many young men and women are currently discerning their vocations as future priests and nuns.

I invite you to learn more about Catholicism in my home country. I hope this information is both enlightening and inspiring. Thank you for your kind attention and generosity.
